10 Tips for Creating Presentation Videos



- 1. Shoot your video HORIZONTALLY (hold your camera/phone horizontally)
 - a. Vertical won't show well on most screens the judges will be viewing from



- 2. Don't use digital zoom
 - a. Move your phone or computer closer, if you need to zoom in



- 3. Be mindful of time
 - a. You'll want to stay with the allowed time for your event



4. Introduce yourself and what you are doing clearly



- 5. Remember to have good lighting
 - a. Set up some extra lamps
 - b. Go outside
 - c. Shoot near a window
 - i. Don't stand in front of a window to film— the light behind you will make it hard to see you



- 6. If you are shooting video outside, be aware of wind and other noises
 - a. Choose a wind-free day or area



- 7. Consider your background carefully
 - a. Make sure your audience sees what you want them to
 - b. Zoom will let you use a digital backdrop if you're in front of a plain wall
 - c. Make it interesting!



- 8. Think about your clothes
 - a. Don't wear company/school logos other than 4-H or Virginia Tech



9. Make a short practice video to check your background, sound, lighting, and to get comfortable in front of the camera



- 10. Avoid shaking
 - a. Hold the camera steady or prop it up on a stable surface
